PNP – **Provincial Nominee Program** – Most Provinces and Territories in Canada have an agreement with the Govt. of Canada that allows them to nominate immigrants who wish to settle in that province. Students studying in Canada may be eligible for faster Permanent Residency under a PNP program. For e.g. if a student studies for MBA from Thompson Rivers University or Masters in Administrative Sciences from Fairleigh Dickinson University, then he can apply for PR after the completion of the course.

Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Newfoundland and Labrador, Northwest Territories, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, Saskatchewan and Yukon are the provinces which participate in the Provincial Nominee Program (PNP). It accelerates the Permanent Resident application process for skilled and/or experienced workers, experienced business persons and their family members who want to settle in these provinces permanently.

Parents can be sponsored to permanently reside in Canada. Besides a new category of visa "Super Visa" has been introduced for parents and grandparents which is valid for upto ten years and allows them to remain in Canada for upto 24 months at a time without the need for renewal of their status.

MASTERS

Masters degrees generally require at least **2 years** of fulltime studies including a thesis (a long essay based on original research), practicum or research paper.

PG DIPLOMA / GRADUATE CERTIFICATE

Generally are of 1 year duration and exceptionally of two years as well.

UNDERGRADUATE

Undergraduate programs leading to a bachelors degree generally four years of fulltime study.

UG DIPLOMA (Post Secondary Diploma)

A UG Diploma generally comprises of two or three years of full time study.

Work Permit for Students

Working on Campus: Initially first six months student can work on campus only. Working off Campus: After six months, on completion of the first semester, subject to student getting an A or B Grade, is allowed to work off campus. If the student secures a C or D grade then he/she is not permitted to work off campus. To work off campus, one has to apply for a work permit. One cannot begin to work off campus until he has secured a **part time work permit**. The work permit authorizes a student to work up to 20 hours per week during regular academic sessions, and **full time during scheduled breaks** (for example, winter and summer holidays, and spring break).

Co-op & Internship Programmes : Many of the programs have inbuilt internships of one or two semesters which provide an opportunity for the student to get first hand exposure and experience in Industry relating to his or her area of study.

Post Study Work Visa

All international students who have graduated from a Canadian post-secondary institution are eligible for Post StudyWork Visa to gain valuable Canadian work experience. To be eligible for a Post StudyWork Visa, international students:

Must have studied full-time at least eight months preceding the completion of their program and should have graduated from :

- ⁽²⁾ A Public post-secondary educational institution (University or College); or
- A Private post-secondary educational institution that operates under the same rules and regulations as public institutions, and receives at least 50 per cent of its financing for operations from government grants; or
- ③ A Canadian private educational institution authorized by provincial or territorial statute to confer degrees.
- O Must apply for a work permit within 90 days of receiving written confirmation from their academic institution that they have met the requirements of their program.
- In Must have completed and passed the program of study and received written notification that they are eligible to obtain their degree, diploma, or certificate.
- ⁽²⁾ Must have a valid study permit when applying for the work permit.
- The Post Study Work Visa provides no restrictions on the type of employment and no requirement for a job offer.

SPP – Student Partners Program

- The Student Partners Program (SPP) is a pilot project designed and implemented in partnership between the Canadian visa offices in India and the Association of Canadian Community Colleges (ACCC).
- Forty Two of ACCC's member colleges have been involved in the pilot program which was launched in April 2009 to improve student recruitment outcomes.
- ▶ At this time, SPP is open to Indian and Chinese nationals only.
- Under this Program the Student applicant who holds the admission from SPP participating Institution without an English Program requirement and also has Guaranteed Investment Certificatewill be put on Fast Track and stands a very good chance of Visa Approval.

Eligibility Criteria For IELTS Under SPP

For Courses after 12th Std i.e. Diplomas or Certificates – requirement of IELTS for visa is 6.0 with no band less then 5.5.

For Bachelors Degree, Post Graduate Diploma or Certificates requirement of IELTS for visa is also 6.0 with no band less then 5.5. However if the institution requires a superior score, that is 6.5 with no bands less than 6.0 or higher then it shall need to be complied with by the student irrespective of the lower basic visa requirement under SPP.

Points to remember for successful Offers and Visas

1. Do not apply for students who do not meet the IELTS criteria. Minimum 6.0 with no band less than 5.5 for UG and overall 6.5 with no band less than 6.0 for PG.

2. Do not apply for students who have several failed courses, large gaps of 5 or more years in studies (regardless of their work experience), and inconsistency in program choice with past studies. Course choice must be relevant.

3. Good academics of the students: We have seen higher rate of visa approval for the students having 60% and above throughout their academic qualifications.

4. Also we have noticed that if a student has low academics as well as has a gap of 2.5 years after completion of last studies, the case is weak and visa may be refused.

GIC – Guaranteed Investment Certificate

According to Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC) guidelines under the Student Partners Program (SPP), students will require approximately CAD\$ 10,000 per year to cover living expenses. This requirement is fulfilled through the purchase of a GIC.

Q. Is it mandatory to purchase a GIC?

A. The Canadian High Commission advises as follows:

PREFERRED OPTION for proof of funds: Evidence of purchase of a Special Guaranteed Investment Certificate (GIC) from a participating Canadian financial institution (**Nova Scotia Bank**), for the amount of CAD\$ 10,000 to cover living expenses for first year in Canada and evidence of payment of advance tuition fee deposit. Under SPP it is compulsory to purchase GIC.

As an alternate option, for Non SPP cases only financial requirements can be fulfilled by submitting a copy of the receipt of the advance tuition fee paid AND a copy of sanction letter of Educational Loan from an Indian Chartered Bank equivalent to CAD\$10,000.

Process of obtaining GIC

Step 1

- Input the information requested in the GIC Application Form in the appropriate fields. (Application Form must be TYPED to be accepted)

Step 2

- Please REVIEW the completed Application Form to ensure accuracy and that no details are missing.

Step 3

- Press the Print button at the end of Page 3 of the form.

Step 4

- Sign the application form. Keep a copy of the Application form for your records.

Step 5

- Scan all documents in ONE SINGLE PDF File, in the following order:

I. Signed copy of the Scotia Bank Student GIC Program Application Form.

II. Copy of passport pages (first and last pages only duly signed by student).

III. Copy of acceptance letter from a Canadian educational institution **duly signed by student.**

Step 6 - Email the SINGLE PDF File to **newaccount@scotiabank.com from the student's email id only.**

Please specify "Scotiabank Student GIC Program" in the subject line of your email.

The student normally receives an automated mail acknowledging receipt of the application. Subsequently an encrypted email is sent to the student within 5 working days containing a log in id and password with which the student will need to log in to a new account through a link provided by Scotia bank.

The student will also get an Investment account number and will be provided with the Wire Transfer details from the bank. With the help of details provided the student will need to transfer CAD \$ 10100 from any Indian bank to Scotia Bank. The additional CAD \$100 is towards processing charges of Nova Scotia Bank. The student will get the GIC , within 5 working days via email. A copy of the GIC needs to be printed and attached in the visa file for the Canada Student Visa.

Once in Canada, the student needs to open a personal deposit account at a branch of Scotia Bank of his choice. CAD \$ 2000 will be initially transferred from the GIC into this deposit account followed by four subsequent instalments of similar amount at intervals of two months each to be used towards his living expenses.

Medical Examination

Student applying for a student visa needs to get a medical examination done by visiting one of the Designated Medical Practitioners in India . The medical examination cannot be performed by the personal family physician of the student. Under SPP it is mandatory to complete a medical examination prior to submission of the visa application. However under the University/Generic Category, it is advised to complete it in advance to hasten the visa processing time.

Documents to be carried to the Medical Test Venue:

- Four recent passport sized photographs with white background.
- · Proper identification document such as passport.
- Offer letter from the University/College in Canada.

• The Medical Report form (IMM 1017E). Only required if not undergoing an Up-front medical exam. The visa office will send you this form.

Note :

• It is important that the doctor is informed about any previous or existing medical conditions. Processing the medical exam could take longer if not done so.

• Medical results are valid for one year

Useful Tips

- > Always provide complete and correct information in the application.
- There are high chances of telephonic verifications, so it is mandatory to include the student's mobile number or any other alternate contact number of the student.
- All documents to be submitted should only be photocopies. Do not submit originals. Only the Medical Form is to be submitted in Original.
- A study plan or SOP is not required but if the course involves a change of field then one can give an explanation for the same of not more than one page.

- Apart from parents if the student has other sponsors including Canadian sponsors, then affidavit of support and proof of relationship is required.
- Students should ideally have 55% in his academics.
- > There should not be a gap of more than 2 years in between the education.
- IELTS score at PG level is preferred to be 6.5 bands even if the requirement for SPP is 6 bands.
- Visa officer do not only see the overall percentage but also the related subject marks of further course of study.
- UG Diplomas can also be done after completion of Bachelors, subject to the diploma is relating to subject to the course contents not having been covered at bachelors level.
